Eneabba Project Update

Eneabba Rare Earth Refinery – State and Commonwealth government referrals

Iluka Resources Limited (Iluka) advises that it has referred the Eneabba Rare Earth Refinery (ERER) to the:

- Western Australian Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) on 26 October 2021 for assessment under the *Environment Protection Act 1986* ; and
- Department of Agriculture, Water and Environment (DAWE) on 12 November for assessment under the *Environmental Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act).

On behalf of Iluka, I would like to thank all who participated in our recent engagement processes prior to these two key referrals. Your contributions enabled Iluka to understand and address your priorities and expectations for the development of the ERER. We will continue to engage with you as the project progresses.

The EPA and DAWE processes provide additional engagement opportunities via formal public comment periods, which could be announced at any time over the coming days and weeks.

The EPA invites public comment through its [consultation hub](#), and DAWE invites public comment through its [EPBC Act – Public Notices page](#); each before deciding whether to assess the project and, if so, the level of assessment required.
